Welcome to the 2021/2022 competition season. Thank you for your continued support. Enclosed you will find information pertaining to the coming season.

GENERAL ALL LEVELS

Note: The AAU National Program will follow the governing body's rules and policies and changes instituted throughout the Competitive year for all levels unless specifically stated with allowance clarifications in the National AAU Rules and Policies. All clubs, program directors, judges, and coaches should be aware of this policy and is their responsibility to monitor any changes within the governing body and apply them to their current program unless specifically recorded as allowances. Contact aunichols@bellsouth.net if you have any questions. Only AAU National Gymnastics Rules will be used at all Regional and National licensed events – no district allowances over and above national program.

Florida Gold District will follow AAU National rules that will be posted on the AAU National website. http://aaugymnastics.org/Rules/RulesHandbook.aspx A copy of those rules will also be posted on the FL Gold website at www.gcgym.com This AAU FL Gold handbook will be also posted on the FL Gold website.

In the fairness of competition for athletes and coaches, who may be competing in both the USAG and AAU programs. Once a gymnast competes in a level, they MAY NOT drop down to a lower level for a competition. Example: Gymnast competes in USAG/AAU competition as a level 4 – May not compete at an AAU/USAG competition as a level 3. This is NOT permitted!!

Remember- all coaches are to share time on events.

Coaches need to be aware of time restrictions on beam, vault and bars. Athletes are taking too long or taking additional chances on a skill - due to coach making additional corrections or athlete not being prepared for her turn. End result is athletes may only get partial/insufficient time for warm-ups. Coaches need to be more aware of time. Coach- DON'T teach! Everyone needs to work together to ensure all athletes get their ample warm-up.

- AAU Age Group Nationals will be held in Springfield, IL June 29th-July 3rd, 2022.
- Please make sure that you register before the deadline for the meet. Late entries will have an additional late fee applied and possibly may not be accepted.

I look forward to having a successful year! Coaches, keep up all the hard work you do with your athletes. Let's make our Florida Gold District shine! If you have any questions, please contact me.

1. AAU Membership

Please make certain to register your club, your coaches and your athletes via AAU National office online at www.aausports.org. Memberships must be renewed each year beginning in August. With the AAU registration process and background screening that is in place for adults, membership approval is no longer instant. Although the delay is not lengthy, please take this factor into account and register early!

Athletes and coaches must have current/active membership to be on the floor.

Meet Directors must verify all coach and athlete AAU memberships prior to each competition. Be sure to submit membership numbers with every meet entry. Entering an AAU competition creates an expressed understanding that all athletes registered are current AAU members prior to competition. Only currently registered AAU athletes, coaches, judges & clubs are permitted to participate in AAU Licensed events.

2. Florida Gold AAU Qualifier Competition Calendar

Events listed on the calendar below are designate Licensed qualifiers to the FL Gold AAU District Championships. Only the events listed are licensed qualifying competitions. <u>ATHLETES</u> must compete in a minimum of 2 AAU licensed competitions to participate at Fl. Gold Championships. -Athletes need to compete at Fl. Gold District Championships to compete at Age Group Nationals

**All AAU Licensed event hosts on the above calendar have signed the Host Agreement, which states that the host will follow Florida Gold AAU award guidelines (outlined below)

Coaches attire:

Please dress professionally while on the floor coaching.

- * Shoes must be worn during the competition. Closed toe shoes are appropriate. Flip flops are not allowed
- * Appropriate length shorts.
- * Females: tops that cover mid-drift and upper areas, no strapless/tank or spaghetti strap tops

3. Competition Guidelines

- FL Gold will follow AAU National rules. Currently we do not have any modifications for our District. All competitions will be judged by NAWGJ certified and contracted judges. Level 1,2, Bronze, Silver may be judged by a <u>one</u> judge panel.
 - Level 3 and up must be judged by two judge panels.
- Awards ALL QUALIFIERS & FL GOLD CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE OBLIGATED TO
 FOLLOW THE OUTLINED GUIDELINES LISTED BELOW FOR AWARDS! There is NO
 individual event placement awarded at levels 1 & 2 (achievement only).
 Level 2 allows All Around placement. Level 1 does not! Event hosts must include awards
 structure on all pre-meet information sheets, including meet info page for AAU Handbook.

Level 1 Provide achievement awards for all events

Provide 100% all around awards in the form of a trophy

Provide all athletes goody bags and/or gifts

Award team placement 100%

Level 2 Provide achievement awards for all events

Provide all around placement awards*

*(Maximum 16 athletes per age group)

Provide 100% all around awards in the form of a trophy

Provide all athletes goody bags and/or gifts

Award team placement 100%

Level(s) 3 & up Award individual placement 50% + 1 per awards group

Award team placement 100%

c. <u>Divisions</u>

Florida Gold will not separate athletes into divisions. Athletes may be divided equally by birth date within each session for levels 3 and up, in order to keep awards groups small and awards percentages generous. A maximum of 20 – 25 athletes per award group is recommended. For level 2 All Around awards, there is to be no more than 16 athletes per award group.

d. Achievement Ribbons for levels 1 and 2

9.5 – 10.0 "Super Blue" (rainbow blues)

9.0 – 9.475 Blue

8.0 – 8.975 Red

Below 8.0 White

(If using alternate color ribbons, follow the above score guidelines, using 4 different colors)

4. Ages for athletes for competition: Per USAG, changes were made to the x-cel program-

Athletes who compete Bronze may enter Level 1,2—and have also reached 5th birthday

Athletes who compete Silver may enter Level 1,2,3—and have also reached 6th birthday

Athletes who compete Gold may enter Level 3,4—and have also reached 7th birthday

Athletes who compete Platinum may enter Level 5,6—and have also reached 8th birthday

Athletes who compete Diamond may enter Level 7,8,9,10—and have also reached 9th birthday

5. Athletes competing out of session:

It is at the discretion of the meet Director to permit/add athletes to compete out of session. It is **not required** for a Meet Director to add an athlete to the meet. If an athlete is permitted to compete out of session, they are **not eligible** for individual or team awards. However, they may be recognized and be given a participation award.

If an athlete arrives to meet at the incorrect session time. It is at the discretion of the meet Director to permit/add athletes to compete out of session. If added, athlete is <u>not eligible</u> for individual or team awards. However, they may be recognized and be given a participation award.

6. Qualifications to Florida Gold District Championships are as follows:

- 1. Athlete, coach & club AAU memberships must be in good standing.
- 2. Athlete must compete in a minimum of **two (2) FG qualifiers** in current season.

 Only meets listed on the calendar in this FL Gold Handbook are designated as FG qualifiers.
- 3. Completed entry form and accompanying entry fees must be received by the deadline.
- 4. Any athlete/club not meeting qualification criteria must be petitioned in-writing by the entry deadline and include any supporting documentation.


7. Qualifications to AAU Nationals are as follows:

- 1. Athlete, coach & club AAU memberships must be in good standing.
- 2. Athletes and club must compete in the Florida Gold District Championships
- 3. Completed entry form and accompanying entry fees must be received by the deadline.
- 4. Any athlete not meeting qualification criteria must be petitioned by the entry deadline and include any supporting documentation. Petition must be submitted to Florida Gold Chairman for approval.
- * <u>Petitions are for injury, sickness-</u> NOT for inconvenient competition date/times, out of town, party, Weddings, etc.

In order to host a Florida Gold Licensed event the member club must be current/up-to-date with any/all fees due associated with hosting competition, is a member in good standing and follow the event guidelines.

* In order to keep in-line with USAG meets for assigning judges and to be placed on the FI. Gold District calendar, All Meet hosting agreement forms, flyers, and judges request forms- need to be submitted starting March 1st-May 1st for the following season.

As a FL Gold AAU Gymnastics event host, I agree to abide by the following:

I. Meet Information & Event Hosting Forms

Event Hosting forms, including all meet information, competition date(s), levels, event site, entry fees, spectator admission fees, etc must be submitted to the AAU Chairman via email to info@gcgym.com

Event information sheets must be submitted to FI Gold Chairman by deadline. Information must be in either pdf,

Microsoft Publisher or Microsoft Word format or a link to the gym website where info is listed.

Hosting Information:

Host club must have an AAU "Club Membership" of Level 2 or 3 - BE PREPARED!

"RENEWALS" for club membership are no longer available. To continue a membership from a previous year, complete the corresponding application below. - 3) On meet information/flyer: It only should show AAU information and must include the following information-:

*All participants must have current AAU Membership. AAU membership may not be included as a part of the entry fee to the event. *AAU Youth Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection. Be Prepared: Adult and Non Athlete Memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at event. Please allow 10 days for membership to be processed. II. Recommended Entry Fees

III. Recommended Spectator Admission Fees

In-house meet \$10 adults/\$5 children

Out of facility \$10-20 adults/\$5-10.00 children

IV. Fee to FI. Gold District.

V. Post Competition Report & fees

Along with the check payable to Florida Gold Gymnastics, Inc. The event host must submit a copy of the scores to the AAU Chair. Send payment of\$1.50 per athlete –deduct deposit amount from total.

VI. AAU Registration

^{*}This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U. S., Inc.

All qualifiers/invitational are open to ALL REGISTERED AAU ATHLETES / CLUBS. The Event Host/meet director is responsible for verifying all club, coaches & athlete AAU Numbers prior to competition.

VII. Competition Deadline & Competition Schedule

Competition Deadlines are recommended to be a minimum of 5-6 weeks prior to the event. Event Host must release their competition schedule 3 weeks prior to the event via, email, website, or Fax.

VIII. AAU Rules, Policies & Regulations

ALL AAU Rules, Policies & Regulations must be followed by the Event Host. This includes, but is not limited to, both National and Local District Rules, Policies & Regulations.

IX. Awards

All AAU Licensed FL Gold District events must follow the complete athlete award guidelines published in the FL Gold AAU Handbook distributed to all clubs and posted online. Achievement award guidelines for levels 1 and 2 must be adhered to. There will be no placement awards for level 1. Level 2 will only have placement in the All Around, and there is to be no award group larger than 16 athletes.

There are four ribbons and score divisions for Achievement awards for Level 1 &2:

9.5—10.0 Super Blue

9.0—9.475 Blue

8.0—8.975 Red

Below 8.0 White

Level 3 and higher: 50% +1 for events. 100% placement for All-Around.

X. Athlete gifts

It is recommended that athletes receive a gift or goody bag/ gift at each competition.

The Florida Gold District by continued preference of our District members, we will follow the rules set forth by AAU National Office. It is each member's responsibility to stay informed of the rules and any changes that AAU National Office may institute during the season. AAU National rules may be found on the AAU website.

FLORIDA JUDGES REQUEST FORM INSTRUCTIONS FOR USAG & AAU LICENSED MEETS

NAWGJ Florida will assign judges on behalf of USA gymnastics and AAU.

To make a request for judges, please use the JUDGES REQUEST FORM included with this instruction sheet and available on Florida USA Gymnastic website.

For mobility /AAU meets only you should submit the form to Florida NAWGJ with the \$3.00 per judge requested – payable to Florida NAWGJ.

Deadline for Judges request for the season will be August 1st

Florida Gold AAU qualifiers must have a minimum of <u>6 week deadline for entries received</u> and a <u>schedule of event</u> <u>must be provided at least 3 weeks prior to event date to all participants and judges assigners</u>. Meet directors may request judges by name or request that a judge not be assigned to their competition. This must be indicated on the judges request form. Requesting a judge does not guarantee that the judge will be assigned.

Meet Directors that don't follow <u>ALL</u> rules for hosting a Florida Gold Licensed event or do not pay the \$1.50 required athlete fee within 30 days will not be placed on the Florida Gold AAU calendar for following season.

NAWGJ regulations and requirements for assignment of judges

It will not be possible to assign judges to an event within 30 days of the competition

Requests to change dates must be approved by SC of the organization and by the FL SJD

If contracts need to be re issued to judges an additional \$3.00 per judge will be due to NAWGJ

A minimum of 14 day notice is required for cancellation of judges. Meet Directors will pay 3 hours of judging time per judge(based on rating) as well as any non-refundable expenses incurred by judges if the competition or judge is cancelled within 14 days.

All requests and fees be paid at least 45 days in advance of the meet date or there is a \$100 late fee.

NAWGJ will assign competitions as placed on the calendar by USA Gymnastics and AAU based on criteria set up by these organizations. In the event there are not enough Florida judges for all the meets on a weekend, it may be necessary to bring in judges from out of state. Meet directors will be contacted to obtain approval due to the added expense before out of state judges will be assigned.

Meet information: the schedule, address of site, meal arrangements for judges, hotel information must be sent to the assigners no later than 3 weeks prior to the date of the competition. If you plan to start your meet early on the first report day, plan on providing hotel rooms to judges the night before.

NAWGJ assigners will contact you using the email on the judges request form to provide you with information that you will need concerning judges assignments.

Helpful Information that may be needed from you by the assigners:

Will the competition have Team Awards? If yes, will the awards be given out after each session or at the end of your competition for each level For 3 day competitions, do you plan to schedule lower level optional or compulsory sessions on Friday or Sunday? XCEL —will you be placing xcel divisions of Bronze, Silver and Gold in the compulsory gym with Platinum and Diamond in the optional gym (compulsory judges may be used for Bronze, Silver & Gold while Platinum and Diamond require level 7/8 or higher judges) By submitting the Florida Judges Request form to NAWGJ you are giving Florida NAWGJ the authority to contract judges on your behalf. You and your organization agree to all the regulations and rules as described above.
